The current global political climate surrounding immigration and a Spanish book titled, "La Aventura de Saíd," about a Moroccan child who immigrated to Spain in the hope of making a better life for his family.

What were the ensemble's collaboratively written theatre-maker intentions? (200 words maximum)

The intention of our performance is to encourage the audience to be conscious of misinformation regarding immigrants and how society is manipulated by the media. In recent years, the use of the media to disseminate information has continued to surge, but at the cost of increased fake news, particularly on immigration. The starting points that led us to examine these social issues were a Spanish book titled, La Aventura de Saíd about a Moroccan child who immigrated to Spain in the hope of making a better life for his family, and the current global political climate surrounding immigration. We want to portray how immigrants are often misleadingly portrayed as "inferior intruders" by media platforms without them having the opportunity to share their narratives. Therefore, we intend for our target audience to be young adults who are in the early stages of engaging with current social and political messages in the media, whose ideologies are still volatile, and who have not yet established their stances on global and political issues. We chose a black box theatre with an end-on configuration as our performance space in order to maximize the proximity between the actors and the audience.
